The Working Group was formed to engage in a negotiated rule-making process to help determine energy efficiency standards for new manufactured homes. The Working Group reached consensus at the end of October and the Dept. of Energy will be posting its recommendations for public comment in the relatively near future with final adoption hopefully in early 2016.
